Psalm 2

Key message:

God is our safe place.

God is our shelter.

God is our refuge.

In great times & in tough times we run to him.

We are not alone

Suggested lesson (pick & choose what suits you and your children):

2. Make a den!



3. Read Psalm 2 v. 12 from Bible

"Blessed are all who take refuge in him" Psalms 2 v. 12

Memory verse ideas (print and cut out houses - last page of this document):

- ☺ hang words on string using pegs. Repeat verse, taking one away each time
- ☺ print page twice and play a matching game: older kids can match the words, while younger kids can use the colours to help them

4. Discussion (in newly made den!)

- Review meaning of the worlds shelter & refuge
- Recall the examples Jimmy & Julie used: (home is a safe place, shelter under umbrella & refuge in den after an argument)
- What scares you? Is there anything you worry about?
- What do you do when you're scared? What do you want to do when you're scared?
- What makes you happy?
- What do you do when you're happy?
- What does it feel like to be safe?
- What do you do when you know that you're safe?

Conclude with key message from above. Refer to their worries/fears and how turning to God would help/does help.

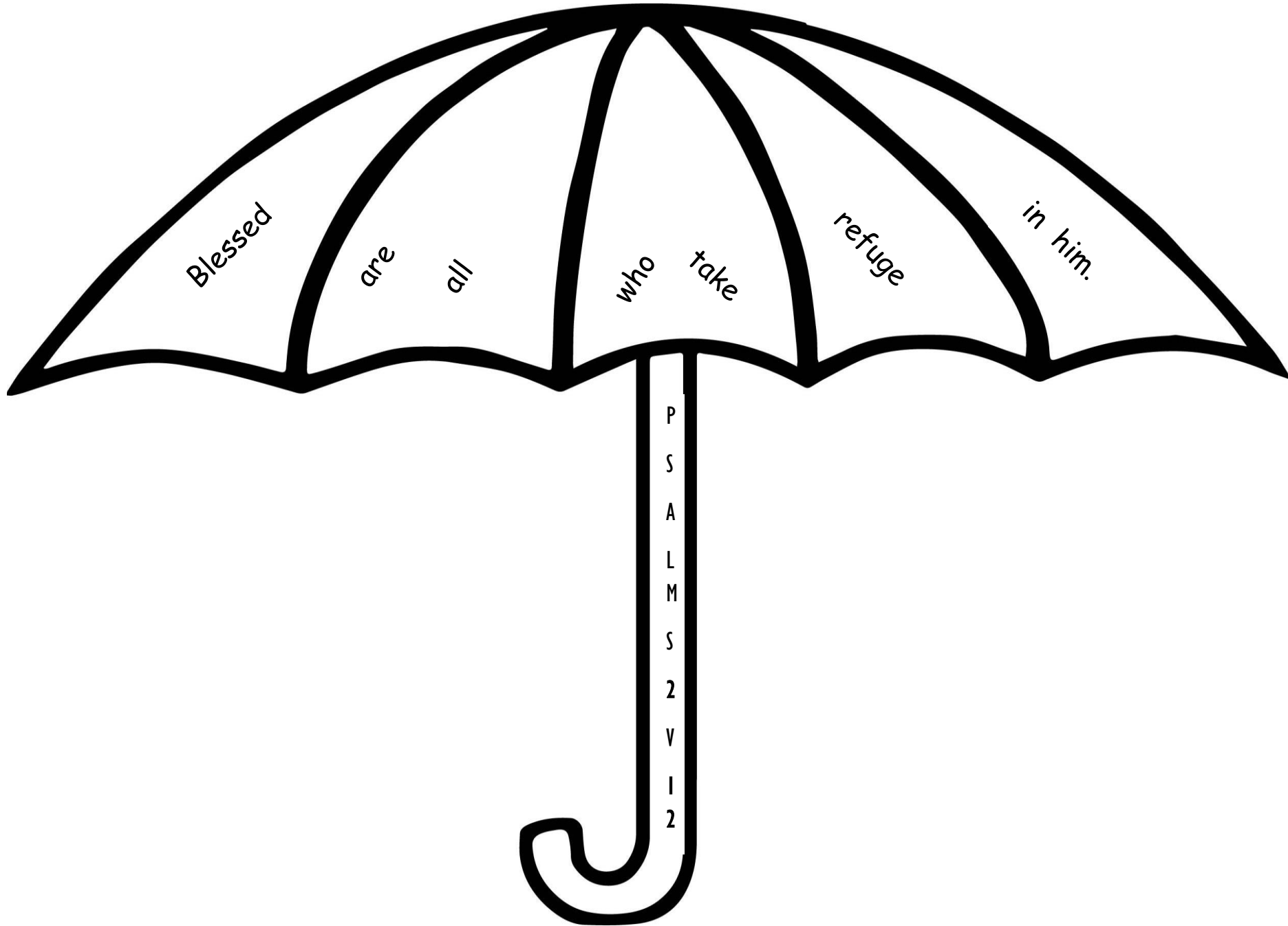

6. Craft/activity

Colour umbrella with the memory verse (print next page of this document). Ideally, cut it out and turn it into a stained glass window by rubbing some oil on the back (cooking oil/baby oil work perfectly) Allow to dry, attach some string if you have it, and hang on the window.

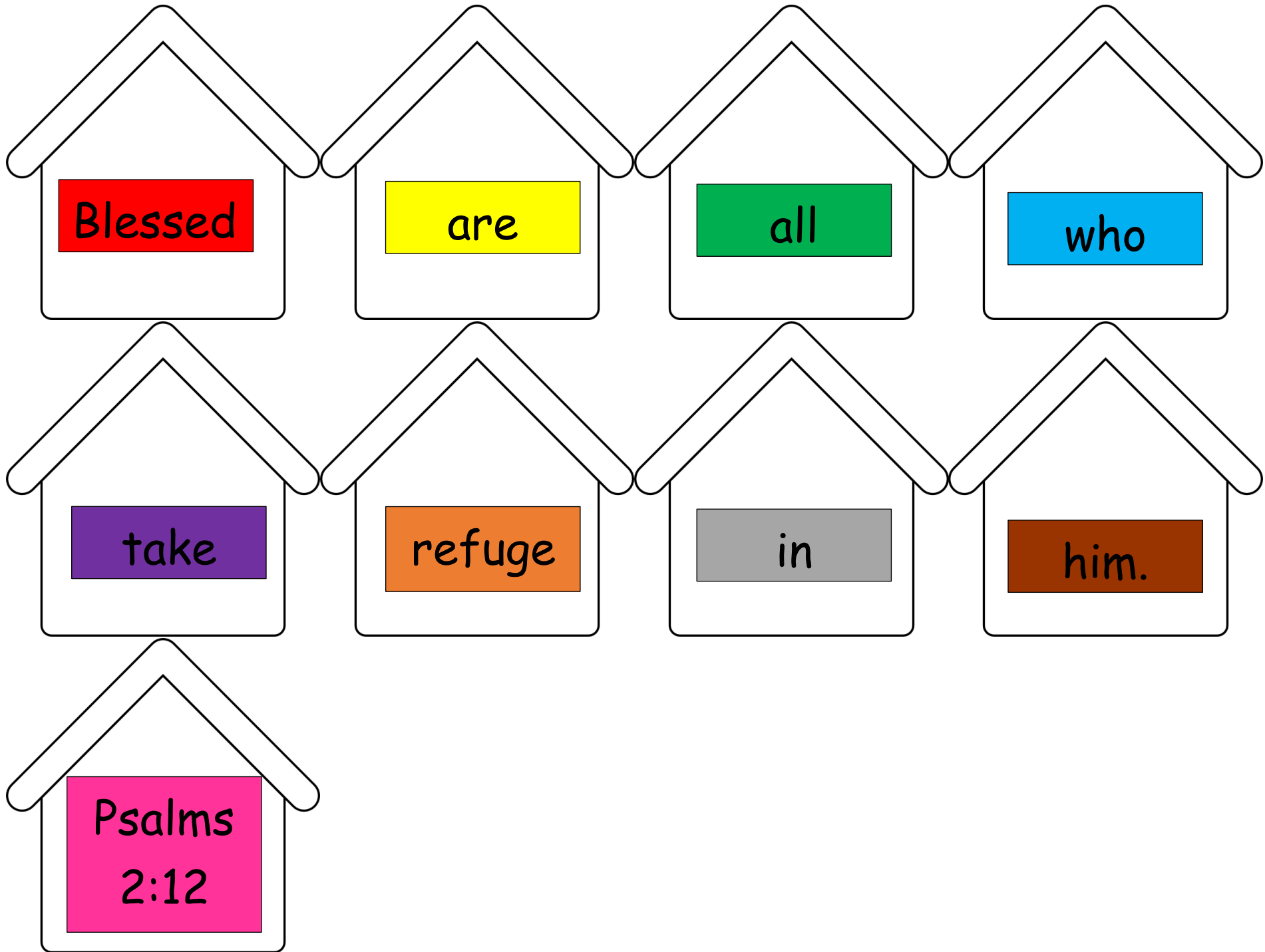
