Activity One:

Make a “God Always Hears Headband”– Read through **Psalm 5:1-3**
International Children’s Bible(ICB)

1. Lord, listen to my words. Understand what I am thinking.
2. Listen to my cry for help. My king and my God I pray to you.
3. Lord, every morning you hear my voice. Every morning, I tell you what I need. And I wait for your answer.

Explain that you’re going to make something to help you remember that God hears His people. Give each child a piece of paper and have them fold it in half (like a card). Have them draw a giant ear on one 1/2 of the page. (an ear is basically a “C” with a smaller “c” inside of it). The ear should fill most of the 1/2 page. Then, with your help and with the page still folded, they should cut out the ear so that they now have 2 ears. Then, give each child enough strips of paper (about 2 1/2 – 3 inches wide) to fit around their head. Help them tape the paper strips together to make one long strip and help them tape or glue the ‘ears’ on the strips so that they fit above their ears. Then, on the paper strip they (or you) should write ‘God hears me when I pray.’ Finally, help them fit the headbands on their heads and tape them in place.


Colouring pages showing how to pray, can be printed and stapled together to form a book on the Lords prayer

God Always Hears Headband

This is to help you remember that God always hears His people.

1. Read through Psalm 5:1-3
 - v1. Lord, listen to my words. Understand what I am thinking.
 - v2. Listen to my cry for help. My king and my God I pray to you.
 - v3. Lord, every morning you hear my voice. Every morning, I tell you what I need. And I wait for your answer.
2. Cut and fold as indicated.
3. Glue, staple or tape the two strips together to form a longer strip.
4. In the middle of the long strip write 'God hears me when I pray'. Write it in big letters using your favourite colour.
5. Glue the ears on the strips so that they fit above your ears.
6. Colour the ears and decorate the strip as you prefer.
7. Fit it around your head and staple or tape the ends of the strip in place.
8. Don't forget ***God always hears His people!!!***
