### Craft 1 – Colouring



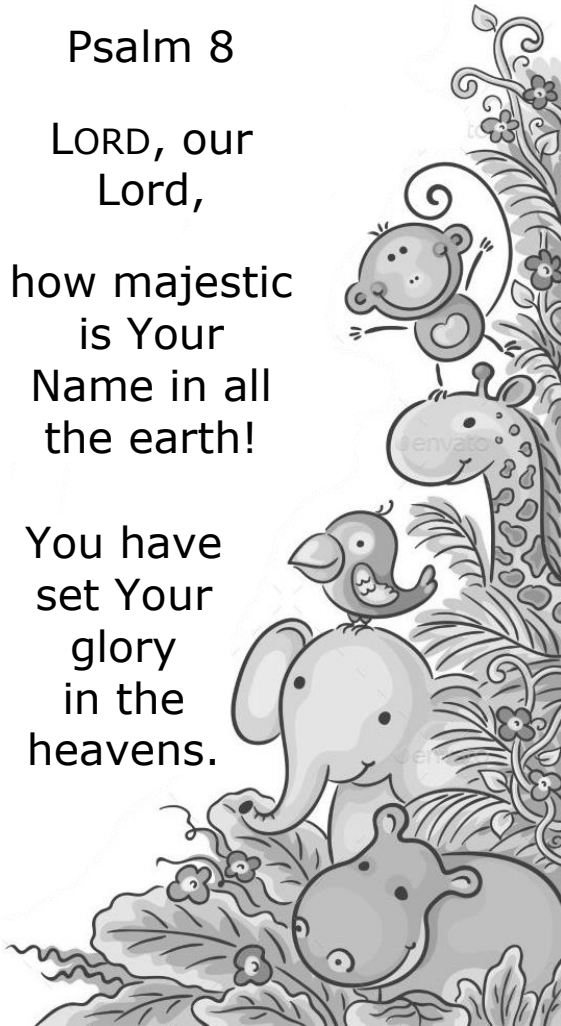
Craft 2 – Bookmark

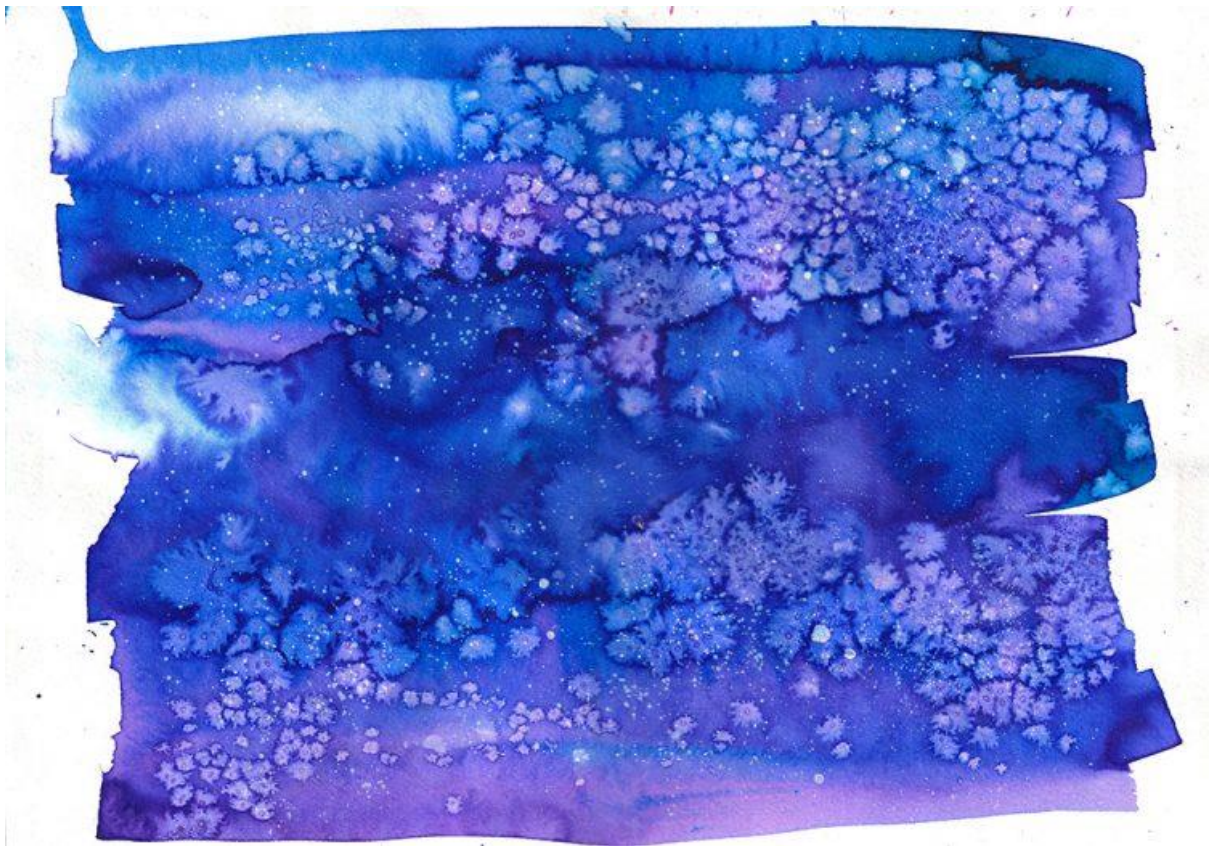

### Craft 3 – Painting Space in Watercolours

1. Select Paint Colours - violet, blue and magenta works well, and some green might be nice.
2. Drip the different paint colours all over the piece of paper. It's lovely to see different colours flowing into each other and mixing randomly.
3. Using a wide brush and some water, do a quick wash over the sheet of paper. Not too much, as the paper would tear if it's too wet
4. Sprinkle with Coarse Salt – do it sparingly so that grains of salt will look like clusters of galaxies.
5. After the washes have completely dried, shake the remains of salt off.
6. Take white paint diluted it with water and flick the paint with a brush to splatter little white dots everywhere.



### Craft 4 – Making Moon Sand

#### Ingredients

- 8 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 cup vegetable oil or baby oil  
(any ratio of 8:1 will do)
- Food colour (if you want to colour it)
- Essential oils (if you want to add fragrance)

#### Instructions

1. Pour flour into a large plastic container or tub and add food colouring and essential oils if you desire.
2. Dump in the oil and mix together with your hands or blender until it is evenly distributed and the flour sticks together when you squeeze it. Add more oil if needed to get the correct consistency.
3. Use a bucket, moulds, scoops, and enjoy.
4. This can be stored for a couple weeks in an airtight container before drying out.
